EPIC for Girls Launches Holiday Donation Drive for Sports Bras to Support Young Omaha Female Athletes

(OMAHA, NE) - EPIC for Girls, an organization dedicated to empowering young girls of color through sports, encourages the community to come together this Holiday Season to support young female athletes. "A key factor contributing to this dropout rate is the lack of access to essential sports apparel like sports bras," said Kimberly Thomas, executive director of EPIC for Girls. Many young girls face challenges in continuing their sports journey due to discomfort or pain, often stemming from not having a proper sports bra.

"This simple yet vital resource can make a profound difference, enabling girls to play sports confidently and without physical or emotional discomfort," Thomas said. The organization believes that this initiative will promote the overall well-being and self-esteem of young female athletes.
